





If you would like to have your company's logo, name, QR code, phone, etc. displayed on or next to a tank in the show area, for advertising, we offer this opportunity for sponsorship of a tank(s).

This shows your support for our koi show and promotes your business!

Sponsoring a tank(s) does not get you a tank in your vendor space and if you don't sponsor a tank, you can still purchase tank(s) for your vendor space and put up any signage you want in your space.

You do not need to sponsor a tank to have a place for your customers to enter your fish into a show. Those are designated vendor show tanks that are made available at the discretion of our show chair people.

If you want to take advantage of this advertising opportunity, the Rocky Mountain Koi Show will work with you to create a banner that will be displayed on, or next to, a show tank(s) that is used by an exhibitor who entered their fish in our show.

We offer two options for this opportunity to advertise your business at our shows, even if you're not present.

Option 1* - \$400 for 4 years (\$100/year) **Option 2*** - \$900 for 10 years (\$90/year)

*If either your company or the Rocky Mountain Koi Club cease to exist during the sponsorship period, this agreement is null and void with no credits, financial or otherwise, due to any party. If for any reason a koi show is cancelled, the sponsorship period will pause and resume the year the next show takes place. Sponsorships are not transferable to another party.

By signing the Vendor Registration form I/We the applicant(s) accept the above statements.




VENDOR BOOTH SPACE

This year we will have a dedicated vendor area with more room for educational seminars. Booth spaces are 10' wide by 10' deep.



We have a limited number of tanks available for vendors - please reserve unless you plan to bring your own tank.







Vendor Information



Please be aware and accountable:

- Each booth is furnished, upon request, with one table & two chairs.
- For select wet vendors, there is the possibility that the show will provide one show tank for you to place any purchases in that want to compete in the show. The water quality of that tank would be your responsibility and as such the show's rules around number of fish in the tank would not apply. If this is of interest please work with a Show Coordinator to work out details.
- Outdoor booths are not secured at night and the Rocky Mountain Koi Show can't be held responsible for the contents. We will have someone onsite who will walk around but their primary purpose is to ensure the well-being of the show fish.
- Booth & tank selections are FIRST COME FIRST SERVE! MAKE YOUR RESERVATION EARLY!
- Due to high demand, if we do not receive your paid confirmation, per the attached contract, you do NOT have a reserved space.
- If you have water in your booth, you must allow our show staff to dispose of it per the venue's guidelines, if you do not and our show receives a fine, **you will be fined**
- If you need to use a hose, you must use it where and how you are directed by one of our Show Coordinators. If you do not and our show receives a fine, you will be fined
